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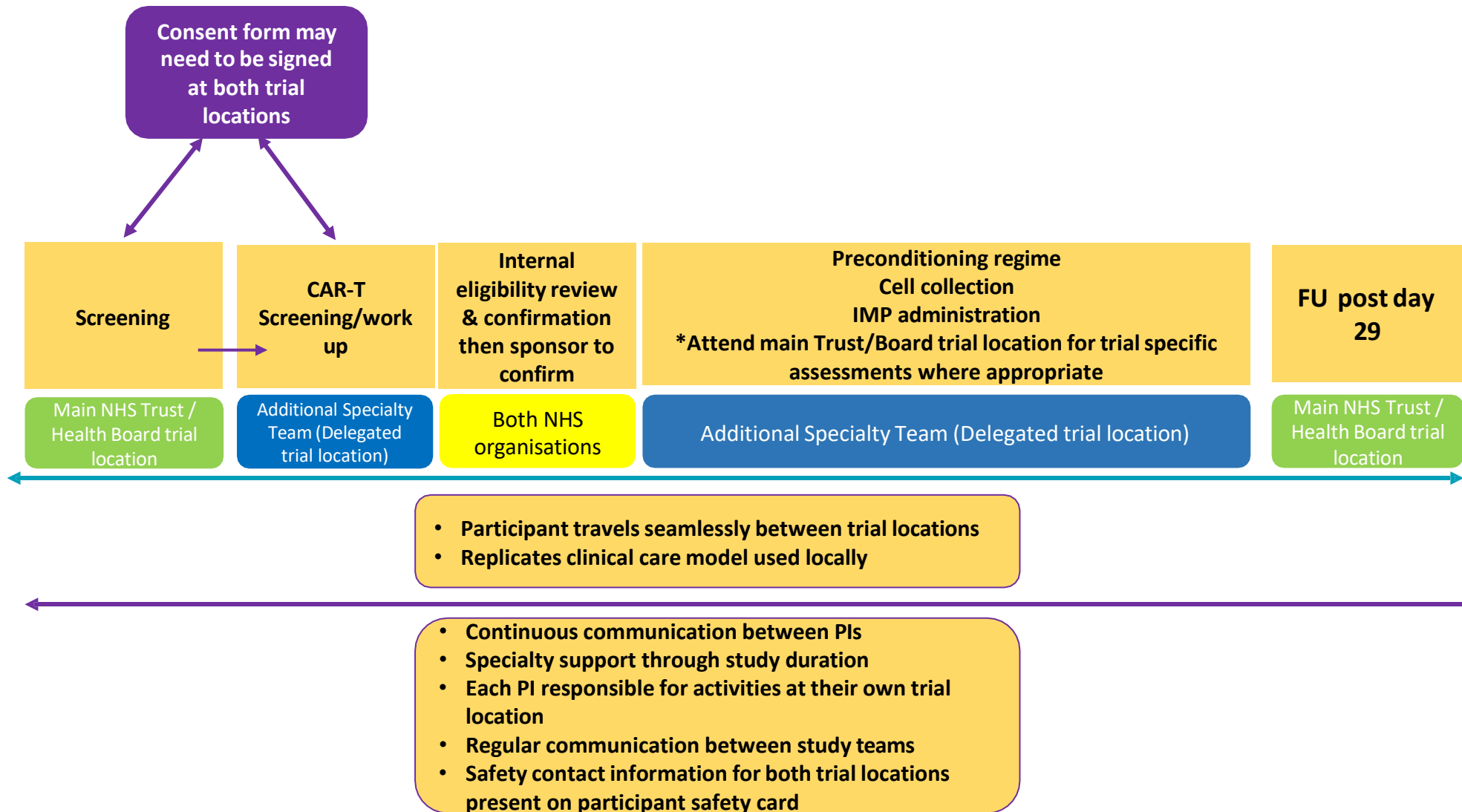

Appendix 4a) EXAMPLE of participant management across NHS Trusts/Health Boards (CAR-T)

Please note: each step in this example may need to be adapted, as appropriate, to create a shared care arrangement for other indications/technologies



Electronic Medical Records (EMR)

- Each trial location responsible for own source data
- Access to be arranged for staff to have access to each others Electronic medical records

Labs

- Each trial location should have own lab kits for their portion of study
- Both trial locations need to be able to see all generated results

Internal Safety Panel Review

- Input needed from both trial locations and sponsor to complete
- Both trial locations risk assessments should be viewed together

Electronic Data Capture

- Each trial location responsible for data entry for their trial activity
- Both trial locations need to be able to view data on each other's systems
